Thanksgiving Basket Brigade is a volunteer run effort that donates and delivers volunteer filled food baskets to families in needy OC communities. Last year, over 200+ baskets were donated in Orange County, and this year we'd like to increase that. Individual volunteers, families, and friends are needed to support this great massive effort.

WHAT GOES IN A BASKET?

Plan to create a basket to feed a family of 4-6. This can be done for \$25 to \$40 per basket, depending on how elaborate you want to get. We like to use a plastic laundry basket (sturdy, practical, and reusable, for \$1 to \$4, check out the 99 cent stores), but a box or any other

container will do. Fill it with a frozen turkey and disposable roasting pan or a canned meat, canned gravy, cranberry sauce, stuffing mix, canned vegetables (yams, green beans, corn, etc.), potatoes (fresh, canned, or in a box), bread, soup, canned and/or fresh fruit, and last but definitely not least, dessert (pies, cookies, pudding, etc.). Add whatever else catches your fancy. Throw in a toy or two for the kids and let your creativity go wild!

OUR GOAL TOGETHER?

100 - 200 baskets this year which will feed about 400 - 800 or more people. Remember that these baskets are individually given so everyone experiences in the giving.
